

Individual Prayer – adopt a leader

Father you are King of Kings and you are King over _____ (*name political leader you are praying for*) (1 Tim 6:15; Rev 17:14). Let your Kingdom come and Your will be done on earth, and in _____ (*country/city where the Leader you are praying for leads*) as in Heaven (Mat 6:9, 10).

Let _____ hear the word of your mouth and praise you Lord together with all the kings of the earth. (Ps 138:4). Let him/her be wise and put his/her trust in You, serve You with fear and rejoice with trembling (Ps 2:10-12). No ruler is saved by the size of an army nor by great strength, but Your eyes are on those who fear you and place their hope in Your mercy. Let his/her soul wait on You his/her help and shield. Let his/her heart rejoice in placing his/her trust in Your holy name, let him/her place his/her hope in You and let Your mercy be upon him/her (Ps. 33:16-23).

Father keep _____ from temptation and accepting bribes so that he/she would establish the land by justice (Pro 29:4; Matt 6:13). Let him/her not give his/her ways to that which destroys rulers, including lust, pleasures and consumption of that which intoxicates lest he/she forgets the law and perverts the justice of all the afflicted (Pro 31:3-5). Let him/her be established in righteousness and not commit wickedness (Pro 16:12). Let him/her turn away from the ways of oppression, bloodshed, bribes, injustice, evil and perversion of all equity (Mic 3). May he/she seek your forgiveness and forgive those who have transgressed against him/her (Mat 6:12).

Father, grant _____ wisdom, prudence, knowledge and discretion and the fear of You, hating evil, pride, arrogance and the perverse mouth (Pro 8:12-14). Father give him/her your judgements and your righteousness (Ps 72:1) and wisdom to rule and decree justice (Pro 8:15, 16). Let the righteous flourish in his/her days and let there be an abundance of peace (PS 72:2, 7). Let his/her mouth not transgress in judgement (Pro 16:10). Let him/her sit in a position of judgement and scatter all evil with his/her eyes and in wisdom sift out the wicked and convict them (Pro 20:8). Let him/her judge the poor with truth (Pro 29:14). Let him/her save the children of the needy and bring justice to the oppressor, redeeming the poor and needy from oppression and violence. Let mercy and truth preserve him/her and let his/her position be kept in lovingkindness (Pro 20:28). Let him/her search out those matters You have concealed (Pro 25:2).

Father let _____ delight in righteous lips and love those that speak what is right (Pro 16:3). Let those who are wicked be removed from before him/her that his/her position may be established in righteousness (Pro 25:5). Surround him/her with friends who love purity of heart and have grace on their lips (Pro 22:11). Let those who excel in their work stand before him/her (Pro 22:29).
